The difference between IT-Visa and IT Card

IT-Visa - is a category of multiple entry visa for foreign citizens coming from countries with which Uzbekistan has a visa regime. It is issued for up to three years with the possibility of extending its validity without the need to leave the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

IT-Visa - is issued by the territorial divisions of the internal affairs bodies of the Republic of Uzbekistan at the place of temporary residence of the applicant based on the recommendation of IT-Park. At the same time, family members (spouse, parents, children) are issued a visitor visa.

IT-Card - a type of recommendation issued by the Directorate to foreign citizens, on the basis of which an IT Visa is issued for citizens with a visa regime, or only an IT Card for citizens with a visa-free regime, to use benefits and preferences.

What are the benefits of IT-Visa and IT Card?

- Receive education and medical services on the terms provided for citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- Without the obligation to re-register at the place of residence to be in any region of Uzbekistan;
- Purchase real estate of any value

(Important! These conditions also apply to family members, holders of IT-Visa and IT Card)

Who can receive recommendations for obtaining IT-Visa and IT

- 1) a foreign investor (or the head of a company acting as an investor) investing in the field of information technology on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- 2) a foreign IT specialist whose annual income for the last 12 months in the field of information technology is at least the equivalent of 30 thousand US dollars;
- 3) founder (participant) of a legal entity - a resident of the Technopark

Documents required to receive recommendations

To receive a recommendation, applicants submit through the web portal the following documents to the Directorate

Foreign investor

- An application with a copy of the passport; detailed information on an investment project in the field of information technology in the Republic of Uzbekistan in the amount of at least the equivalent of 10 thousand US dollars;
- an extract from the bank confirming the availability of the amount of the proposed investment in the field of information technology in the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- a letter (petition) from a legal entity – a resident of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the implementation of an investment project with the applicant or a document confirming the opening of a legal entity on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan with an authorized capital of at least the equivalent of 10 thousand US dollars;
- a copy of the decision of the founders (participants) of the investor's company, confirming the authority of the head of the company

Foreign IT specialist

- an application with a copy of the passport;
- a document confirming the applicant's annual income for the last 12 months from the date of application in the amount of at least the equivalent of 30 thousand US dollars, confirmed by the bank or the relevant authorized body;
- a letter (petition) from a legal entity – a resident of the Republic of Uzbekistan – an employer confirming his intention to accept for the applicant's work as an employee in the field of information technology;
- a document (diploma, certificate or resume) confirming the applicant's specialization and qualification in the field of information technology;
- information about accompanying relatives (spouse, parents, children).

Founder of IT Park resident company

- an application with a copy of the passport;
- name of the Technopark resident company;
- a copy of the certificate of residency;
- information about accompanying relatives (spouse, parents, children).

6th stage	Directorate	Makes an appropriate entry in the Unified Electronic Register of Recommendations.	during 1 business day
